



2018 Home Energy Professional Energy Auditor Pilot Prerequisites

Experience [within the last 3 years] (see template letter in application): Minimum 1,000 hours from:

- Field/technical position within the home performance or related field, OR
- Performing audits in a building science trade, OR
- *Trainers or BPI Field Proctors only:*
 - Trainers or BPI Field Proctors may qualify under the experience requirement with proof of 1,000 hours of relevant training or field proctoring (or a combination of each). 1 hour of relevant training or field proctoring equals 1 hour of experience.

Energy Modeling [within the last 5 years]:

- 10 energy models that comply with BPI 1100-2.2 (with proof) OR
- Successfully complete at least six (6) hours of energy modeling training that includes an end of course assessment, with a passing score

Additional Requirements [within the last 3 years] (see template letters in app):

20 points from any combination of the following:

- Building trades experience (framing, roofing, drywall, etc.):
Max 10 pts, 5 pts for each 1000 hours
- Training from industry-specific training center:
Max 10 pts, 5 pts for each 40 hours
- Related industry certifications (must be active to receive credit): (e.g., RESNET, BPI, NATE, EPA, others).
Max 10 pts, 5 pts per certification
