This position is 40 hours per week, Monday through Friday.

Responsibilities: Daily supervision of construction crew members. Perform weatherization techniques that ensure greater energy efficiency for each unit serviced, up to and including installation/repair of windows and doors, blown-in insulation and air sealing measures. Strong organizational skills required to document all aspects of a project, such as the materials utilized and the monitoring of equipment. Ability to problem solve issues that may arise, ultimately ensuring the proper completion of work scopes.

Candidate will be required to obtain specified certifications (employer sponsored).

Qualifications: High School Diploma or equivalent, three years of residential construction experience (i.e. installing windows, doors and finish work). Two years supervisory experience and ability to travel to complete certification courses. Knowledge of the use and maintenance of hand tools. Clean NYS Driver's license required. BPI certification a plus.

Pre-Employment Requirement: Please note that applicants for this position will be required to complete a pre-employment drug screen.
