

Project:HOMES is seeking a person interested in becoming full time Crew Leader working in Central Virginia. As an Energy Conservation Crew Leader you will work with the Energy Conservation Department team to improve the energy efficiency of homes which qualify for our program. The Crew Leader travels to clients' homes with crew and manages all field operations. Using the energy audit the crew leader guides the team to complete the scope of work for weatherization. Our crew leaders' work hands on with crew members and work in confined spaces such as attics and crawl spaces, and inclement conditions.

A Crew Leader needs good carpentry skills, basic plumbing knowledge and able to use various power tools. Our staff must communicate effectively with a wide variety of clients, be self-motivated, and able to balance competing demands. Most importantly, our crew leaders must desire to make a positive difference in the community.

Project:HOMES is a non-profit housing agency dedicated to Improving Lives by Improving Homes. For the past 25 years we have served Richmond, Virginia and twelve surrounding counties by weatherizing homes to make them safer, more energy efficient and to reduce their carbon footprint.
