

DOE Weatherizaion Assistance Program (WAP) energy audtior/inspector

We are a DOE funded low income weatherization program which is part of Oregon's second largest housing authority. This is a career position. We 150 to 200 homes a year. Our primary targets are manufactured homes and multifamily complexes. We also work on single family stick-built homes. We do the audit. Determine what can be done to save energy and the home. Write a work order and arrange for a contractor to do the work. We follow up 100% with a QCI inspection and then pay the contractor. There is a lot of desk time and documentation. Staff need to be willing to crawl in attics and crawl spaces. Our staffing includes 4 BPI QCI/energy auditors.

QCI preferred. Residential certifications preferred

Required to be fully certified as QCI, building Analyst, Inspector etc... within 16 months of hire
