Responsibilities

The **Energy Efficiency Quality Control Inspector** will perform residential whole-house diagnostics, comprehensive energy assessments, and verification of installed measures in support of the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) home performance programs.

Key Responsibilities:

- Ensure compliance with Program requirements, contract terms, and Ethics Policies.
- Attend regularly scheduled internal (IBTS) trainings.
- Demonstrate proficiency with all necessary energy efficiency diagnostic equipment and inspection procedures.
- Maintain all necessary certifications required for inspections.
- Utilize specialized software to identify appropriate site inspections and schedule inspections.

- Utilize specialized software to obtain necessary documents for use in inspection services including completed job paperwork for reference and creation/use of inspector intake form.
- Perform desk review of completed projects using appropriate documentation and jobsite photographs as directed by managers.
- Maintain calendar/schedule on daily basis to ensure accurate and timely tracking of availability for inspections.
- Perform comprehensive field diagnostics and measure evaluation inspection services on an as needed basis to ensure compliance with industry standards and program requirements.
- Submit all necessary findings and scoring for Quality Manager (QM) review and approval.
