JOB DESCRIPTION

Resource Innovations is seeking a **Weatherization / Quality Control Inspector** to join our team in Chicago, Illinois. This position will support the delivery, execution and evaluation of programs and projects across Company's operations by conducting in-field project inspections, working with complex data sets, and completing data validations within the software platform. This position works closely with trade allies, customers and internal team members to review weatherization and energy efficiency project specifications for adherence to program guidelines, conduct residential single family and multi-family comprehensive home retrofit inspections, and work with our partners to identify and implement solutions. The Quality Assurance Analyst must be able to work effectively across teams and independently.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct onsite inspections in single family residences, small multi-family tenant units and large multi-family properties, write assessment reports, and provide solutions to assist trade allies in remedying failed inspections
- Develop and implement quality assurance / quality control ("QA/QC") requirements and implementation plan
- Provide education, training, and coaching to trade allies to minimize failed inspections, mitigate faulty workmanship, and remedy failures when they occur
- Leverage best practices and continuous improvement to implement long term solutions in partnership with the client and Resource Innovations' Program Managers
- Generate weekly, monthly, and ad hoc reports to audit, monitor and measure performance and relevant metrics
- Manage the process of regularly reviewing and updating critical program documentation including field verification guides and forms, processing manuals, and policy and procedure manuals
- Work with clients, internal team members and subcontractors to ensure reporting and invoicing requirements are met
- Support establishing systems for data collection, reporting, record keeping, recurring and ad hoc analysis in support of project implementation efforts
- Support budgeting and financial management, produce invoicing, forecasts and projections
- Ability to perform, interpret and articulate research and data analysis, and assist in the development of client, customer and partner presentations
- Travel between 25% to 50% of the time (primarily in Northern Illinois) and other tasks required
