Summary:

The Weatherization Technician works as a part of the weatherization team to install measures designed to improve the energy efficiency of buildings. This position performs direct service installs, including the installation of home weatherization materials, minor building repairs, repairs to stop cold air infiltration and associated record keeping.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Install Weatherization program measures such as:
 - a. window and door weather stripping
 - b. aerosol foam sealant
 - c. door sweeps
 - d. window and door caulking
 - e. rim joist insulation
 - f. water heater insulation jacket
 - g. water heater pipe insulation
 - h. radiator
 - i. furnace filter
 - j. space heating pipe and duct insulation
 - k. basement under porch wall
 - I. incidental repairs
 - m. blower door guided air sealing
 - n. knee wall
 - o. attic hatch insulation
 - p. blown and batt insulation

- q. thermostat
- 2. Conduct work in compliance with OSHA and CSC safety procedures as directed by supervisor.
- 3. Perform blower door and combustion efficiency testing.
- 4. Handle job site clean-up.
- 5. Install or repair windows and/or doors.
- 6. Make minor structural repairs and carpentry work as required.
- 7. Perform other installations or repairs as called for by supervisor.
- 8. Use hand tools or power tools in a prescribed, safe manner when installing materials and repairing structures.
- 9. Perform other duties as assigned.

Requirements:

- 1. High school diploma or equivalent required.
- 2. 1-3 years construction experience preferred.
- 3. Familiarity with hand and power tools.
- 4. A desire to learn weatherization techniques.
- 5. Must be able to crawl through and work in constricted spaces.
- 6. Basic knowledge of the construction of residential dwellings and housing types.
- 7. Valid driver's license.
- 8. Perform the essential functions and physical demands of the position with or without accommodation.
